

BUSINESS:

Motion to Untable Diesel Bids – Jerry made the motion to untable the bids John seconds the motions. Roll Call was Yes by all. Jerry made a motion to reject the diesel bid from M&J excavation, and to shop around as needed. John seconds the motion. Roll Call was Yes by all.

Motion to Advertise for Request for Qualifications for Sewer System – Attny Mills asked if there were any questions on the packet that was drawn up and sent to the supervisors for review. There were no questions. Jerry made the motion to advertise. Georgiann seconds the motion. Roll Call was Yes by all.

Engineers Report – Mary stated that they are updating the bid documents to include the new standards per PennDOT. Once all is updated then they will apply for a HOP. Tom stated that he is working on reviewing the master stormwater permit for Citterios and he should have it completed by next week. Jerry asked Tom to look into the alley by the Della Croce property because there was a request for the twp to block it off. Tom stated that the twp should make the alley way accessible for the people that have garages there. As far as he can tell the twp owns the alley not Della Croce. Jerry agrees that unless they can prove proof of ownership, it is the twps alley. The supervisors will meet with Tom at the site to discuss what needs to be done. The board would like Chris Spock to get together with Tom to go over what roads need to be paved so Tom can apply for grants.

Sewer Report – Jerry stated that he has been in contact with Ray Clymer and FMA would like the supervisors to attend their next meeting. Jerry will be attending. They are concerned about the high infiltration from Foster and Citterios. Tom asked if Jerry can find out if he can get a print out of the flows, because the twp does not have access to them.

Solicitors Report – Attny Mills explained that Ms. Rahman has appealed to the supreme court, but her time will expire next week. The Jones case is continuing with on going discovery. Jerry asked about short term rentals during the COVID-19 reopening phases. It was suggested that all owners of short-term rentals be sent a letter stating the CDC guidelines they should be abiding by. Attny Mills announced that there is a planning commission meeting on 6/16 for twp agenda items.

Zoning Report – By Georgiann: Keith received complaints about Larry Sarosky’s property for debris and an odor. No permits were issued for the month of May. Pending violations at the Magistrate have been continued to July.

•John stated that the twp has asked Freeland to assist in the sweeping of the streets, we are awaiting an answer. Butler Twp asked for help hauling asphalt on 6/23, John approved. He also stated that Chris gave him information on a 2001 Volvo grater, the one that the twp currently has is broken (water pump & brakes). Jerry suggested that they look into renting one not buying one. John was also asked about a possible pick up truck to be used for errands. The board agreed that it is not necessary.

•Georgiann received email from the Census that only 52% of Foster residents have replied. She asked Lisa to put it in the newspaper to remind everyone that this is very important for grants and other funding.

Jerry was approached by the Freeland Little League; they are asking the twp to make a motion for them to resume their season with guidelines in place. Jerry made the motion. John seconds the motion. Roll Call was Yes by all.

•Georgiann spoke with Diane Thomas. Unfortunately, she will not be returning this year with the farmers market due to COVID-19 and being short staffed.
