

BUSINESS:

Engineers Report- Mary explained that she is working closely with DEP and Pennvest to close out the loan and she feels things are definitely moving forward. She also said that she has only received two calls in regards to the letters she sent out to crescent rd, so if anyone at the twp receives calls please direct them to her. Jerry said that he had 4 or 5 people ask him about it.

Tim explained that since the meeting with DEP on the 14th, the water authority has given the information need for capital contributions, and it was submitted to Pennvest. Pennvest agreed that it is sufficient to use. They spoke about removing the Wyoming Street pumping station from the project. Attny Karpowich said that it is definitely going to be removed. Attny Karpowich said that he is hopefully the twp will be getting \$500K of pennvest funds released in the next two weeks. He is also working closely with Pennvest to come up with an affordable rate for residents.

The Freeland pretreatment ordinance is still under review by the engineers.

Zoning Report- Keith explained that he issued 6 zoning permits; 5 of which were for accessory structures and one was for a change of use for Summit Propane, there will be no bulk storage there. Jerry asked if they wanted to do bulk storage in the future what will have to be done? Keith said that it would have to go for zoning approval. He had inquiries about the noise ordinance and if it covers fireworks, it does not and if you read the noise ordinance there would have to be someone certified to read the decibel levels. 307 Fern St has high grass and there is no one to take care of the property, the owner is in a nursing home. 434 Green St and 117 Fern St, the grass has been cut after notices were sent. Keith spoke with Mr. Sarosky about his property and gave him an additional 30 days to clean it up. The garage that burnt on Park/Luzerne St is being fixed. 417 Hemlock has deck issues, the owner has corrected them. Hess trailer park is not listening to the property owner, and he came to Keith for help. He sent letters out to homeowners. The truck on Adams St was removed. The complaint against Ryan Montgomery is at the magistrate. In regards to the Biggan property, Keith spoke with the PennDOT Dunmore office and they will be investigating and sending letters. Mike asked about the concrete that was poured on the side of the road by Maple Lane. Keith will look into it. As for the Robert Jones property Keith is requesting no parking signs be posted so the State Police can take action on him parking vehicles on the right away. He sent him a letter of violation because he has no use permit for what he is doing at his property, he is claiming sales and service.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mr. Wilfing asked about the unregistered, dismantled vehicles that are scattered throughout the twp. He asked since we have the ordinance to cover these issues why isn't anything being done? The twp is not taking action. Keith said he is working on multiple issues.


