## OLD BUSINESS:

## NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Wheel Loader Bids** – Ryan made the motion to accept the lowest bid from Highway Equipment for the Volvo @ \$135,535. Georgiann seconds the motion. Roll Call was Yes by all.
2. **Ordinance #2 of 2017** – An amendment to the Landlord Tenant Ordinance to eliminate the applicability section, therefore it will apply to all landlords. Mr. Wilfing commented that the board should review the ordinance because it does not match the building code. The appeal process needs to be reviewed as well. No other public comment. Attny Karpowich asked for a motion to adopt the ordinance. Georgiann made the motion Ryan seconds the motion. Roll Call was Yes by all.
3. **Ordinance #3 of 2017** – Amending Chapter 230 to include stop streets. A list of streets can be obtained at the twp office or on the twp website. Ryan made the motion to adopt the ordinance. Jerry seconds the motion. Roll Call was Yes by all.
4. **Repository Sale** – Property on Forest Road, with a bid of \$500 from Sandra Murphy. No comment from the board.
5. **Engineers Report** – Tim had paperwork that needs to be submitted to DEP.
6. **Solicitors Report** – Attny Karpowich told the board that Keith called him and would like a revised and consolidated fee schedule. Attny Karpowich will prepare one for the next meeting.  
He also suggested to the board that an ordinance should be created for a weight limit on Duda Road. The road is currently being subjected to large trucks. He has received various complaints about the truck traffic. MetroCast is changing to Atlantic Broadband and the Franchise ordinance needs to be amended. Attny Karpowich prepared a resolution stating that the Township would like to obtain the AgMar roads and the extension of Highland Heights for Liquid Fuels purposes. Jerry made the motion to adopt the resolution. Ryans seconds it. Roll Call was Yes by all.  
Attny Karpowich let the public know that he is still waiting on the ZHB to certify the record for the Land Use Appeal, then it can be listed for argument.  
Attny Karpowich spoke about the damage to the backboard at the basketball court in Highland. The state police do not have enough evidence to press charges. The parents of the boy were contacted and are not willing to settle. Attny Karpowich said that he can file a civil complaint for the cost of the backboard. Georgiann made the motion to go ahead with the civil complaint. Jerry seconds the motion. Roll Call was Yes by all.  
Anna Marie Durange requested a lot consolidation waiver. The end result will be a .37-acre lot. Jerry made the motion to approve the waiver. Georgiann seconds the motion. Roll Call was Yes by all.
7. **Zoning Report** – 6 zoning permits and 2 building permits were issued. Twp checks were completed and violations were sent out.

## CORRESPONDENCES:

Correspondence was received from Hickory Hills in regards to gun shooting. They would like to have the board remind the public of the laws that need to be followed.

## PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mike Spock provided an email to the supervisors in regards to an address change for the Benyo property, for easier access. The board will approve the change. He would also like a letter from the twp recognizing the Fearnots as the fire dept that services Foster Twp, because they would like to purchase from the Federal Surplus again.

Mr. Welshko would like to know what the legal width of a road is. 33' so it would be 16.5' from the center line. He told the board that there are bushes by the curve that need to be cut back and they have been like that for years.

Shari Petrovich asked what is being done about the foundation in Hickory Hills, they have been waiting for years for something to be done. They have submitted many complaints over the years. She said the association has tried, but they can't do anything else, and now they would like the twps help.

Pat King would like to remind the board about the berm of the road, the post office will not deliver the mail. He would like a status update of renting the equipment for it.

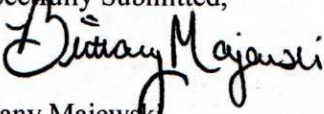
