

NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Resolution #6 of 2017** – Fee Schedule: Attny Karpowich addressed the changes with the ZHB applications and the Demolition permits. Jerry made the motion to approve the resolution. Ryan seconds the motion. Roll Call was Yes by all.
2. **Resolution #7 of 2017** – amending the cable franchise agreement to consent to the assignment of a new company. Nothing changes for the Twp. Jerry made the motion to approve the resolution. Ryan seconds the motion. Roll Call was Yes by all.
3. **Engineers Report** – Tim Holden was present and had copies of the letters that were drafted to the governor. The board agreed that they will need to be looked over.
4. **Solicitors Report** – Attny Karpowich updated the residents on the Land Use Appeal. He explained that since there is no certified record yet he cannot go ahead with the findings and facts, and he cannot list it for argument. He also suggested an executive session for personnel matters.
5. **Zoning Report** – Jerry read report: Completed twp checks, with one violation that is 119 Main st in Upper Lehigh, sent notice of violation. Other pending violations have been addressed and satisfied. There is a magistrate hearing on the house in highland, next to the playground, on November 1st. Six zoning permits were issued, one driveway permit and six building applications were approved. The Kaufmann hearing was continued. Appointments were had with residents building and zoning questions. Stormwater applications were issued where required.

CORRESPONDENCES:

Jerry would like to announce the Comedy show since Mike Spock was unable to attend tonight’s meeting. The show will be at the Freeland Events Center on November 11th. Jerry is not sure of all the times but dinner is at 5pm. Jerry gave the audience a brief description of the complaint from Mr. Pavuk, stating water is pooling in his driveway since the road was paved. Jerry said that he will get back to him but unfortunately there are higher things on the agenda, and the water is most likely coming from his own drains.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Pat King asked about the berm of the roads. Ryan said that the machine is coming on Monday. Pat said the postmaster will be coming on Tuesday to see if he can give the ok. Merri would like to know what the holdup is with the ZHB. Attny Karpowich is unsure why the hearing is not transcribed yet, he has multiple calls into Attny Hludzik. She is concerned that the same thing that happened 20 years ago will happen again. Merri would also like to thank the board for the signs in Ag Mar and the use of the street sweeper on the roads. There are still some issues on Michaels & Sheaman (uneven and holes). She would like to know when the engineers are going to come out to check the sewers since the paving was done, she does not want them to get backed up with debris like before, which caused her \$6K worth of damage in her basement. Attny Karpowich explained that there seems to be some kind of confusion with Aqua because they want to charge the twp to do this. A resident had a complaint about 321 Fern St, he lives at 357 Fern and has been complaining since 2008 and nothing has been done. Someone was there to clean up but they keep leaving the trash bags. The board is unsure what the zoning officer has been doing to help the situation. A resident from Detweiler Ln asked the board to please raise the speed limit from 25 to 35 mph on Caplos Rd. He said that Harrisburg has it listed as a 35 mph road but the signs say 25 mph.
