

ORDINANCE NO. 3 of 2023

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 98, STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, ARTICLE II, OPENING AND CUTTING OF STREETS, SECTION 198-8**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Foster Township Board of Supervisors, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, that Section 198-8 of Chapter 98, Article II of the Foster Township Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

**Chapter 198**

**STREETS AND SIDEWALKS**

**ARTICLE II**

**Opening and Cutting of Streets**

**§198-8. Permit Issued Within Five Years of Paving; Additional Charges.**

No permit shall be issued to excavate or open a Township Road within five years after the road has been paved or repaved unless the issuance of the permit is authorized by a resolution of the Supervisors. If issuance of the permit is authorized, the applicant shall patch and restore the road opening by infrared pavement repair technology to blend uniformly with the adjacent existing road. If the road opening is greater than or equal to fifty (50) linear feet in total or two hundred (200) square feet in total, whichever is less, upon completion of the same, the applicant shall restore the Township Road by milling and repaving the entire road surface from edge-to-edge, or curb- to-curb, for the full length of the excavation in accordance with the specifications of this ordinance. The road surface shall be restored to its original condition as determined by the Township Engineer.

Except as amended above, the ordinance shall remain the same, and become effective immediately following its adoption.
