

**TAX LEVY RESOLUTION
RESOLUTION NO. 60 OF 2016**

A Resolution of the Township of Foster, County of Luzerne, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the year 2017.

BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby resolved and enacted by the Board of Township Supervisors of the Township of Foster, County of Luzerne, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

That a tax and the same is hereby levied on all real property and occupations within the township of Foster, subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2017, as follows:

Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of42 Mills
On each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of042 Dollar
On each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation

For fire equipment & protection purposes, the sum of11Mills
On each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of011Cents
On each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation

For road machinery purposes, the sum of07 Mills
On each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of007 Cents
On each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation

The same being summarized in tabular form as follows:

	Mills on Each Dollar of Assessed Valuation	Dollars/Cents on Each One Hundred Dollars Assessed Valuation
Tax Rate for General Purposes	<u>.42</u> Mills	<u>.042</u> Dollar
Tax Rate for Fire Protection& Equip.	<u>.11</u> Mills	<u>.011</u> Cents
Tax Rate for Road Machinery	<u>.07</u> Mills	<u>.007</u> Cents
TOTAL	<u>.60</u> MILLS	<u>.060</u> Dollar/Cents

Special Levies shall be as follows:

Light Tax


- (1) On Improved Properties:
 - (a) Highland - .48 cents per front foot;
 - (b) Upper Lehigh - .46 cents per front foot;
 - (c) Woodside - .66 cents per front foot; and


- (d) Youngstown - \$29.40 per property owner.
- (2) On Unimproved Properties:
 - (a) Highland & Upper Lehigh - .24 cents per front foot; and
 - (b) Woodside - .26 cents per front foot.


The 1% Realty Transfer Tax (½% Foster Township and ½% Hazleton Area School District), the 1.5% Earned Income Tax and the \$52.00 LST shall continue in effect for the fiscal year of 2017. A ten (10%) percent penalty is imposed for non-payment of real estate taxes after one hundred twenty (120) days of the date of issuance.

That any resolution, or part of resolution, conflicting with this Resolution be and the same is here by repealed insofar as the same affects this Resolution.


