**Error on Mr. Petrick's Sewer Report** – Georgiann stated that she would like to make a correction to the sewer report Mr. Petrick gave last month because there was an error in addition. The delinquent accounts currently owed to the twp are \$52,052.28 less than what he reported. Mr. Petrick apologized for the error.

**Engineers Report** – No engineers were present to give a report.

**Police Report** – by Brittany: The twp was covered for a total of 242 hours.
