







Bill Wilkus asked if the zoning officer can come down to Hickory Hills because there are violations everywhere that have not been taken care of in a long period of time. Wilson stated that complaint forms need to be filled out and given to Brian.

Mark Lachewitz asked if the short-term rental policy applies to Hickory Hills and if anyone is grandfathered in? Wilson stated that yes it applies to everyone in the twp, and no one is grandfathered into this policy. He explained that letters have already gone out from the zoning office regarding it. Mark also asked about the possible help that Foster was willing to give to get a grant. He stated that the financials that were not being presented, are finally available. Wilson explained that our engineer does our grant writing and its at a cost to the twp. Mark stated that they are just looking for someone to possibly shadow. Wilson explained that he does them for the fire company and all grant writing really is, is telling a really good detailed story.

Joy Kroening asked about the rental fees and inspections and if they will be submitted to the twp? She also would like to know what is going to happen to the people that do not have a rental permit? The board explained that there is a new fee for working without a permit along with the other fines for not following the ordinance. She stated that nothing is being done in Hickory Hills and there are people renting and not getting permits. Wilson stated that since this is so new, its going to take some time to get everything in order and get everyone to comply, but as he previously stated the first set of letters went out and a second set is going out this month. The landlords need time to get all the information needed, they have that right.

Jim Shanda asked if there was an actual fine for violation of this policy. Wilson stated that yes there is a fine for not following it, starting with the working without a permit fee of \$150. He asked about a copy of the ordinance and the board explained that it can be found on the twp website.

Janet Mele would like to know how someone can go about finding out the allowable occupancy of each rental home? She has had several issues with the renters that have been there, various violations all of which she has documented with the police. Wilson asked her to please submit them to Brian as well. She asked if the rental permit can be taken away. Wilson stated that yes it can just like any other permit, if there is an issue. The board explained that the occupancy is set by the UCC and goes by square footage.
