**BUSINESS:**

**Motion to Advertise Zoning Ordinance Amendment to Chapter 77** – This amendment will allow for civil and criminal enforcement for the IPMC. Gerogiann makes the motion to advertise. Mike seconds the motion. Roll Call was Yes by all.

**CALO Subdivision** – Attny Walsh stated that all the conditions that the Planning Commission requested have been completed, except for one that their title searcher is working on. Mr. Yanuzzi stated that if the board could approve it conditioned upon that title search he would be ok with it. Mike made the motion to approve the subdivision. Georgiann seconds the motion. Roll Call was Yes by all.

**Engineers Report** – Tim that he reviewed all bills from FMA regarding chemical expenses, and he does believe that it would be considered maintenance, so the twp would be responsible for their share. He also stated that he reviewed the holding tank ordinance and there are a few items that he would like to review with the attny before anything is done. Attny Walsh said he would review his concerns and contact him.

**Solicitors Report** - None

**Zoning Report** – Georgiann gave the report: Keith completed twp checks, and complaints were received. He is in the process of issuing violation notices to a property on Washington Street and Centre Street. He also sent out notices for properties in Hickory Hills. The one property removed a carport that did not meet requirements. Both residents complied and completed permits for their structures. Another property was in violation of a non-permitted structure, but he is still awaiting a return application. Three building permits were issued and 2 zoning permits. He attended hearings at the magistrate, one of the defendants was found guilty on for counts and the judge dismissed one. Another defendant was found guilty because he did not attend.

Pat King stated that he issued 3 complaints in AgMar for quality of life. He was called to the property at 531 Foster Ave in regards to buildings being built on the complainant's property. There was in fact multiple buildings that were built on his property, therefore they were posted. He stated that there are problems with both properties, for excess vehicles and such. Attny Walsh stated that he is partially involved with the situation.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

A resident spoke about the work that was done on Caplos and Valley road. He stated that there are still potholes that need to be fixed. He stated that the roadcrew is there every single day and they do not do anything to them, the drive over them. He said he even tried to flag them down. Mike stated that he is going to find out why they are there every single day, and the next time they are there to give him a call. The gentleman also asked who is responsible for the street sweeping in Polonia Estates? He stated that when the twp was there with the street sweeper they started to go up the sides of the street, and then he heard another worker tell the guy in the sweeper to only go up the middle because he didn't want to have to clean the sweeper out. Mike said he is going to get to the bottom of it.

A resident from 533 Lakeview Dr spoke about the water issue in AgMar, along with his neighbors. Mike stated that he was down the other day when it was raining and he saw the water situation, and knows what needs to be done with swales and catch basins, but he doesn't know where the twp is going to get the money to complete the work. The twp will look into what can be done in the interim.

Kurt Detweiler spoke about the condition of the roads and that they are only getting worse. He would like to know where his tax money is going since the roads have just been getting worse over the last two years.

Mr. Welshko would like to know if a pile of stone/dirt, like what was left on Caplos, could be left on Meir Rd and his son will repair the road himself. Mike stated that he does not know about the piles of material left on Caplos Rd, and he is not comfortable with leaving material out for anyone to take.

A resident stated that the corner of Oak & North Sheaman needs to be repaired it is completely gone. Mike stated that the guys are working on filling in corners for AMS to come through and repair the roads. The gentleman also asked about the playground in AgMar, and if it is being updated? Georgiann said yes, it is, because everything down there is original and hasn't been updated in over 30 years.

Greg Capozzelli asked if the infiltration problem that was present here in town has been taken care of, since the rains have been heavy he would like to know. Mike and Jerry stated that everything is working properly.


