BUSINESS

Blue Triton Stormwater Agreement – Attny Favreau explained that this was approved a while ago, and has now been reviewed and has been determined to comply with the stormwater ordinance. John made the motion to approve. Todd seconds the motion. Roll Call was yes by all.

Conditional Use Application – A hearing was held prior to this meeting regarding a conditional use application by Mr. Evancho. There will be a decision made within 45 days.

LSA Grant Resolutions – Brittany explained that she has the following resolutions to apply for the local share grants: Hemlock Street \$368,000; Green Street \$262,000; Spring Street \$148,000; Brickyard Road \$206,000 and a Recreation Match of \$73,000. John made the motion to approve all resolutions for grant applications. Todd seconds the motion. Roll Call was yes by all.

Safe & Social 2025 – Brittany explained that this is going to be like National Night out for the kids. It will be hosted by the Rec Board and WHPD. This is a completely free event happening this Friday from 5-8pm here at the municipal building.

Engineers Report – No one present.

Sewer Report – Nothing to report.

Solicitors Report- Nothing to report.

CORRESPONDENCES – MMI asked for assistance for their crosscountry meet on Sept 3rd. The board approved the assistance.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Alice Lachewitz mentioned that since the meeting was cut short last month, she was unable to speak about the June meeting minutes being inaccurate. Brittany stated that Alice spoke to her after the meeting and they were already changed. She asked about rumors that the WHPD will be gone. John and Todd agreed that they are just rumors nothing is in the works to stop the police coverage.

Susan and Kerry Ernst expressed their displeasure with the trucking company next to Valley Gorge MHP. They state that the zoning officer does not enforce the two ordinances and all the notices they were given have now expired and they would like to know what is going to be done. Attny Favreau stated that they may want to consider private counsel if they feel they are not getting the outcome they like. John stated that he is going to talk with Brian and see what is going on down there and what can be done by the twp. The residents would like to see an 8' fence be put up so they do not have to see what is going on there.

Bill Heller asked about the land formerly owned by Norman Ackerman on Oley Valley Rd, it is located in a C-1 zoning district and his client Mr. Conti would like to purchase to develop into short term rentals and he wants to make sure it is still allowed. Attny Favreau stated that it is on a case by case basis and once application is made it will be heard by the ZHB, the supervisors are unable to answer a question like that.

Patricia Novak a resident of Valley Gorge MHP asked if the violation notices are accessible online so the community can follow along. She also wants to know about the environmental concerns and the elderly people living there. She was directed to contact DEP if she has environmental concerns because the twp cannot address them, because they are considered a state level issue.
